2022 RESTAURANT LICENSE RENEWAL

Please be advised that your calendar year 2021 City of Mishawaka Annual Restaurant License will expire January 31, 2022 and will need to be renewed.

Step 1: Contact the St. Joseph County Health Department (235-9750) to obtain your 2022 Food Service Permit

Step 2: Bring your 2022 St. Joseph County Food Service permit into the Controller's Office in City Hall located at 600 East Third Street, Mishawaka, IN to obtain your 2021 City of Mishawaka Restaurant License

Step 3: The total fee for a 2022 City of Mishawaka Restaurant License is **\$50.00**.

- This amount includes the annual Fats, Oils and Grease fee (see below).
- After February 28th a late fee of \$20.00 will be added bringing the total to \$70.00.

We accept cash, checks or money orders.

The Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG) ordinance was implemented in 2010 to reduce blockages to the sanitary sewer system and reduce maintenance costs due to FOG discharges from local food establishments. As this program has expanded and evolved, periodic reviews are done to ensure that all local food establishments that fall under the FOG ordinance are in compliance.

If you are receiving this letter, your establishment has been identified as one that is required to register and pay the annual fee. If you feel that your establishment has been identified for the program in error, please call the Mishawaka Department of Engineering at 258-1619 and reference the FOG letter. However, please be aware that any establishment that produces and/or serves any fats, oils, or greases will not receive an exemption.
